Watch Out for... High Risk Moments in ICU

Watch Out Notice: 06

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What is this?

A reminder of six moments in ICU when serious mistakes can happen.

These are usually due to human error.

What are our top six moments?

Prescribing and adjusting heparin infusions

Make sure you use the most recent blood tests for the correct patient.

Rapid sequence induction

Use the checklist, organise your team and prepare your backup plan.

Inserting central lines and arterial lines.

Avoid distractions, watch out for needle-sticks and use the safest technique.

Adjusting drug doses based on lab results

Make sure you use the most recent blood tests for the correct patient.

Using off-formulary or unusual drugs

Double-check with a colleague, ask the pharmacist and hand over clearly.

Admitting and discharging patients

Use a structured handover and speak directly to colleagues outside ICU.

Protect Your Patients:

During high risk moments, think "what can I do to make this safer?"
